Dear Parents and Students,

We hope you have had a wonderful summer thus far. While I'm sure it feels like summer just started, it is time to start planning for the start of the upcoming school year. Here in the middle of July, our intention is to return to school in as normal a manner as possible. In addition to these forms all students interested in participating in athletics need to complete the required MSHSAA forms through Privit. The link to create or update your account is on the Athletics Tab under Tryouts & Physicals Tab of our website, <https://www.stdominichs.org/athletics/tryouts>. ImPACT Assessment needs to be done every two years. Athletes who will be playing sports and did not take the assessment last year need to take the ImPACT Assessment before the first day of tryouts. The link for the assessment is available from the Athletics tryout schedule page. Please note that athletic physicals are now valid for two years, as is your impact test. However, all athletes must update information and electronically sign required paperwork every year for MSHSAA through Privit. The following MSHSAA Pre-Participation Documents are required every school year:



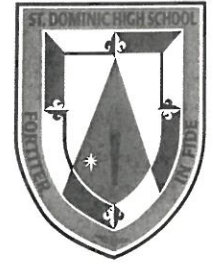

Pictures/Dress Code: All **sophomore and junior** students are to wear dress code skirts, pants or shorts with a non-uniform shirt that is appropriate for school yearbook pictures. No sleeveless shirts or off the shoulder shirts are allowed.

Parking: Only students who complete the online parking form and bring the required documents with them will be allowed to choose their parking space. You will need the confirmation email that you received after you submitted your parking application (either a printed copy or the electronic copy on your phone or tablet), your driver's license, and \$30 payment (cash or check or paid online with a Credit Card).
