Living the Dominican tradition of prayer, study, community and service, we encourage lifelong growth in faith, knowledge and leadership and involvement in the global community.





Director's Note

Where do I begin? When I chose Anastasia last year as our spring musical I had no idea it would be my last show here at St. Dominic, nor did I know that we would be doing a show set in Russia at the same time there is war and devastation occurring by Russia in the Ukraine. We have taken this opportunity to have history lessons during rehearsals, discussing the Revolution in Russia and the true story of the Romanov family and it has turned out to be a perfect last show- a huge show, with beautiful costumes, a large set, and a super talented cast and crew. What more could a director want? So why Anastasia? It is a fairytale, a romance story with drama. It has light hearted comedic elements and of course a happy ending. (even though the true story of Anastasia Romanov did not have a happy ending) When choosing a show, we always try to choose one with a learning, touching, or even moral theme/thread throughout the show, a show that we can relate to one or more of our 4 pillars here at St. Dominic and of course, our faith. Anastasia is no different. Anastasia actually means resurrection. What could be a better theme to discuss during Lent? Our title character gives hope to children, and individuals who have been touched by or experienced separation from family or a loss of family, that it is possible that one day they will be reunited with their loved ones. Anastasia also gives young girls a role model to look up to and know that it is okay to be determined, strong and to go after what you want and believe you will achieve it and most of all to have faith. Gleb finds that history doesn't have to repeat itself and that it is okay to have a heart, to care about someone and to forgive. As Paulina says so movingly at the end of The Winter's Tale: "It is required you do awake your faith."

I want to take this time to say thank you to all the students, parents, faculty and staff that have made my time here so memorable. The Crusader Players have given me an opportunity to really find myself as a director, teacher and mentor. I will always hold the past nine 9 years and all "my kids" near and dear to my heart. Enjoy the show.
