Merit-Based Freshman Scholarship Opportunities

Each scholarship requires an application, plus other criteria as noted below. Applications are due Friday, March 15, and recipients will be notified Friday, May 10. Each incoming freshman may apply for up to two merit-based scholarships. Only registered incoming students with registration fee paid in full are eligible to apply for scholarships.

Academic Scholarship

\$1,500 to all eligible scholarship applicants; renewable

- ITBS composite score of 95% or higher in seventh and eighth grades
- "A" average (no more than one B) final report card in seventh grade and first quarter in eighth grade
- Good attendance and discipline report

Amy E. Dickherber Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 to two students per class

- For students who are involved in fine arts
- Please attach: Short essay (300-500 words) describing fine arts involvement

Composition Scholarship \$1,000 to three students; renewable

- For students who excel in writing
- Recipients must maintain a B average or higher in English courses
- Please attach: 1000-word essay describing a time you encountered an unexpected situation

First Responder Family Scholarship \$1,000 to three students; renewable

- For children of police officers, firefighters or paramedics
- Please attach: Document indicating family member's line of duty

Leadership Scholarship

\$1,500 to two students; renewable

- For students who have demonstrated leadership throughout elementary school
- Renewable for students who remain in good standing at St. Dominic
- Please attach: Short essay
 (300-500 words) detailing
 leadership roles; principal letter of
 recommendation (required)

Legacy Scholarship

(formerly Alumni Scholarship) \$500 to five students; renewable

- For students who are the child or grandchild of St. Dominic alumni; recipients must complete 10 hours of service per year at St. Dominic events
- Please attach: Document listing parent/grandparent alumni and graduation years

Military Family Scholarship

\$1,000 to two students; renewable

- For children of veterans or active/ reserve members of the armed forces
- Please attach: Document indicating family member's area of military service

Outstanding Service Scholarship

\$1,000 to four students; renewable

- For students who have displayed a history of serving others
- Annual requirement of performing 40 Christian Service Program service hours per school year (15+ hours beyond standard 25-hour requirement; accrue June 1-May 31)
- Please attach: One-page essay detailing service history

Performing Arts Scholarship

\$1,000 to three students; renewable

- For students who excel in theater, band or chorus
- Recipients must annually participate in performing arts at St. Dominic High School
- Please attach: Short essay (300-500 words) describing performing arts involvement

Robotics Scholarship

\$1,000 to two students; renewable

- For students actively involved in robotics teams
- Recipients must participate in St. Dominic High School's robotics or engineering programs
- Please attach: Short essay
 (300-500 words) describing
 robotics involvement; robotics
 instructor letter of recommendation
 (recommended)

STEM Scholarship

\$1,000 to four students; renewable

- For students who excel in any combination of science, technology, engineering and/or math
- Recipients must maintain a "B" average or higher in STEM courses
- Please attach: Short essay (300-500 words) describing STEM involvement; teacher letter of recommendation (required)

Visual Arts Scholarship

\$1,000 to one student: renewable

- For students who excel in visual art
- Recipients must annually enroll in a visual art class or be an active member of the National Art Honor Society or similar organization
- Please submit: One piece of art (will be returned)

- Need-based; open to grades 9-12
- For students from a single-parent home
